One of my fondest committees is a tournament that raises money in honor of a Baltimore County fire fighter that was killed during a training exercise. With my help over the last few years we have been able to take a golf tournament that was only raising a few thousand dollars a year to a tournament that has now raised over \$125,000 in scholarship money for students pursuing a career in public safety.
