Being a part of the GCSAA Grassroots Ambassador Program allows you to be an advocate for the industry and affect change. Being an Ambassador gives you the opportunity to:

Grassroots Ambassadors build relationships with Congress and are the go-to people with lawmakers and their staff on golf course management issues. As a Grassroots Ambassador, the most important thing you can do is share your story with Members of Congress.







BECOME A GCSAA GRASSROOTS AMBASSADOR

WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR...

GCSAA is seeking enthusiastic and motivated members to serve as Grassroots Ambassadors. Ambassadors should project a positive image, be in good standing within the chapter and community, and have an interest in government issues. Ambassadors are paired with members of Congress based on golf facility location in most cases. Time commitment to the Ambassador position is minimal, generally requiring less than two hours a month. What's most important is for Ambassadors to strive to build a relationship with their member of

Congress and his/her staff over a two year period. During this time, Ambassadors should:

- Watch a series of how-to videos on advocacy and participate in a few "live" webinars annually
- Create an advocacy outreach plan with GCSAA staff
- Meet personally with assigned policymaker or his/her key staff at least two times each year*
- Attend Grassroots Ambassador training at the Golf Industry Show (if attending and available)

*Meeting options include: attend an August recess town hall, have a meeting in the district office, attend National Golf Day and/or host a golf course site visit.
