

GCSAA Delegation 2027 sponsored by Bernhard Academy – Links to Success

Terms and Conditions

Travel Requirements

- Delegates must commit to the specified trip dates (23 January – 30 January). No changes or extensions are allowed, such as remaining in the U.K. after the Links to Success experience.
- Bringing a spouse/partner/colleague is not permitted.
- Applicants must possess a valid passport and have no issues entering the United Kingdom.
 - If entry to the U.K. is denied, the individual will bear responsibility for any resulting consequences and related costs.

Visa and Vaccination

- Visa - the delegate will be required to apply and pay for any visa needed to make the trip (ETA - £20) <https://www.gov.uk/eta>
- If vaccinations are required, the individual will be responsible for ensuring that they are vaccinated.

Costs

- The delegate will be responsible for all transport and housing costs related to their travel to and from the international departure airport.
- Costs not covered during the trip include personal food and drinks.
 - Many meals will be provided. Delegates will be informed about which meals are their responsibility.
 - Personal expenditures including gifts, transport (where not already provided).

Attendance

- If selected but unable to attend due to personal reasons, the trip will be forfeited.

Insurance and Health

- Delegates must have adequate travel insurance, including medical coverage suitable for the destination.
- Delegates are required to disclose any health conditions to the organizer, including details on how to manage potential episodes during the trip.

Behaviour and Conduct

- Any activities or actions that could harm the reputation of the delegate's employer, GCSAA, or Bernhard may result in the withdrawal of their invitation.
- Inappropriate behaviour prior to or during the trip that affects the reputation of the delegate's employer, GCSAA, or Bernhard may lead to dismissal from the delegation. The individual will be responsible for all related costs including cancellation fees.

Communication

- Sponsors and associated companies will co-ordinate trip arrangements through email, WhatsApp and telephone. All selected delegates will be required to join a WhatsApp group.
- Images and video content taken during the trip may be used for:
 - Creating news stories, social media posts.
 - Marketing purposes for the promotion of future delegations.
