# **2022 GCSAA Best Management Practices Grant Program Guidelines**

The following guidelines will govern the Facility BMP Grant applications and review of them for recommendations to the board of directors for approval:

# **Organization qualifications:**

- GCSAA affiliated Golf Course Superintendent Associations (chapters).
- Turfgrass Foundations, universities, and other not-for-profit organizations working with golf course superintendent associations.
  - GCSAA affiliated chapters will be engaged in the approval process for any and all submissions to ensure their acceptance and coordination of any non-chapter organization's application.

# Acceptable activities:

Applicants may apply for up to \$3000. Applications should only incorporate one or more of the following activities which must be focused on encouraging members to create a facility BMP manual:

- Efforts (marketing, communications, education, etc.) geared toward facility adoptions of BMPs.
- Projects that provide for the significant demonstration, comparison, and/or effectiveness of golf course best management practices.
- Development of validation or verification programs for proposed or existing best management practices programs for golf courses.
- Marketing and incentive packages for chapter BMP programs.
- The development of the review and update of existing agronomic and environmental best management practices for golf course development, operations, and maintenance.

## **Requirements:**

- Chapters must encourage members to use GCSAA's Facility BMP Planning Guide (on-line tool) to create a facility BMP manual.
- Chapters must develop a basic plan with goals for the number of members completing a facility BMP manual and timelines for completion.
- Activities are restricted to the aforementioned activities.

# Priority consideration will be given to applications in the following order:

- Chapters that have not received a previous facility BMP grant (not awarded to "state" previously)
- Projects that support hands-on workshops or similar events that allow superintendents to start or write their plans on site using GCSAA's facility BMP tool.
- Marketing, communications, and education plans geared toward facility adoption of BMPs.
- Incentive activities

# <u>Timeline</u>

## Note: There will only be one application period in 2022

<u>Application Period:</u> January 15, 2022 – Applications open March 15, 2021 – Applications due to GCSAA

## **Application process:**

- Applications must be submitted using the BMP Grant Application form available on gcsaa.org or by contacting GCSAA.
- Applications from non-golf course superintendents' associations must have letters of support from the supporting golf course superintendents' associations accompanying complete application forms.
- Email with attachments is acceptable by the deadline with original signature copies mailed to GCSAA.
