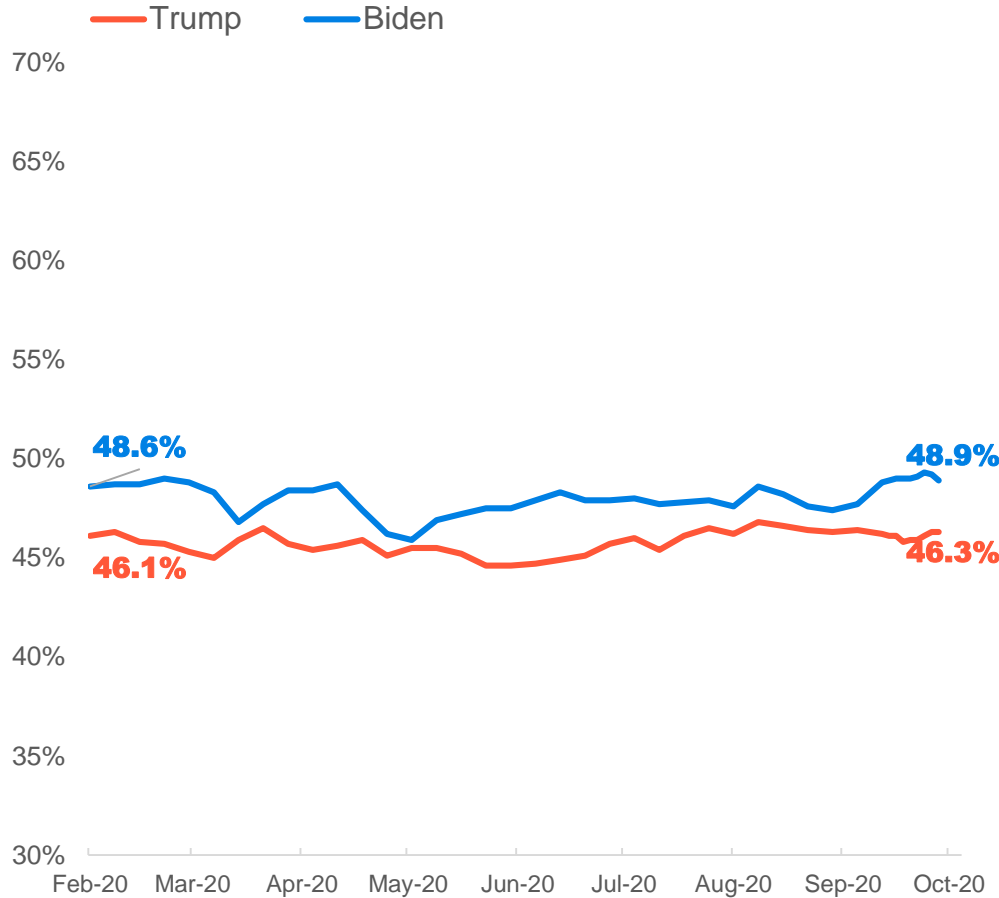


Head to head presidential polling: North Carolina
