 Shooting over 20 on a par 4 from the red tees wasn't fun and took a long time.
- Local families were taking their kids elsewhere as-the course is hard and we didn't have a junior fee rate.

Why Did We Add Forward tees?

 My kids had already begun playing from randomly selected locations in the fairways.

- 4. Allow faster players to play through.

- 2008 -No recorded junior rounds and revenue
- 2009 -151 junior rounds, \$2,885 (+ adult = ?)
- 2010 -230 junior rounds, \$4,664
- 2011 -212 junior rounds, \$4,264
- 2012 -334 junior fee rounds, \$11,370
 - 10 junior season passes, \$6,000
 - ?# junior season pass rounds
- 2013 -322 junior fee rounds, \$13,195
 - 15 junior season passes, \$9,000
 - ?# junior season pass rounds
 - More high school kids bought season passes
- Round counts don't included high school rounds and season pass rounds.


















Summary
