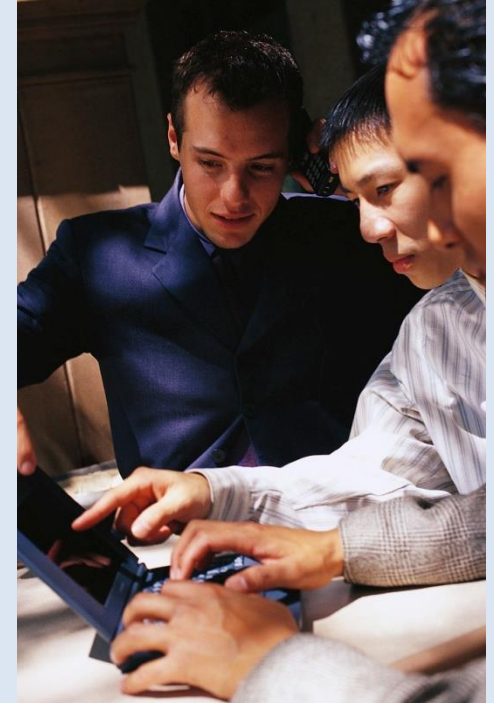

Limitations: Stored Communications Act

- Federal statute prohibiting intentional, unauthorized access to private electronic communications such as Facebook or Gmail
- Creates privacy expectation in private electronic communications

What About Invasion of Privacy?

- Key to tort action is proof of an expectation of privacy
- Issue under state law
- Many courts are reluctant to find an expectation of privacy in information on the internet
