- Changes to the course this include No. 8 green renovation, #14 and #15 tee complex renovations, and a complete renovation of bunkers, sand swap and sodding of edges throughout the golf course.

- Forward tees were rebuilt on holes 11, 12, 14 and 17.

- One year ago, three combined acres of native grasses were introduced on holes 9, 10 and 12. The year before four combined acres were added on holes 2, 4, 11 and 15.

- The drought on the west coast continues to impact water supply.
