- There is re-routing for the tournament. Tournament No. 1 and No. 2 are the members' No. 8 and No. 9. The South's No. 1 will be the tournament's No. 3 and will be played from the North Course No. 1 tee box.
- The oak tree located to the right side of the tee box on the original No. 1 was bent by Native Americans to mark the trail when traveling from Detroit to Saginaw.
