- Changes to the course prior to last year include a new tee on No. 1, which is 25 yards back; new joint tee on No. 9/17 with No. 9 playing 25 yards longer and 17 playing about same distance, but angle plays the hole across the water; flowers planted around pro tees.
- Albany has hosted the tournament since 2015. Victor Hovland is the defending champion.
- The superintendent position is presently unfilled. James Povey served in the position for seven years.
