- Area has had challenging leadup with more than 6 hurricanes / tropical storms in the last 3 months.
- Under the golf course are remains of the "Mansion" Governor Daniel Tucker's residence in 1617.
- The West Whale Fort is next to the golf course.
- Jayson Jackson became a superintendent at age 29 and is the only superintendent on the island who manages 27 holes (also the only public courses on the island).
- The maintenance staff is entirely Bermudian and majority were at course for 2008 renovations.
