#### **Additional Notes**

- Course has five par 5s and five par 3s, with three of each on the front nine.
- Course change in the last few years include a new tee on No. 1 (25 yards back), a new joint tee on No. 9/17 with No. 9 playing 25 yards longer and No. 17 playing about the same distance, but the angle plays the hole across the water. Flowers have also been planted around pro tees.
- There are seven Ohio State agronomy interns volunteering tournament week.
- Stormes has spent his career working in tropical areas as well as in Canada.
