#### **Additional Notes**

- Average fairway width in landing areas: 28 yards.
- Changes to the course include: #1 moguls long of the right fairway bunker were strengthened and three small pot bunkers were added. #9 Extended to get option to play 20 yards longer. #15 Replaced rough grass area right side fairway bunker with trees and natural landscape materials.
- Stadium Course closes to play three weeks prior to the tournament.
