Notable

• Since last year's tournament, the back nine restoration has been completed. The front nine was completed ahead of last year's event.

- The back nine greens are only eight months old.
- The two-year project restored greens and bunkers back to the original design.

• Course has converted 25 acres of irrigated turf into native, non-irrigated areas.

• Course brings in recycled water to save more than 40 million gallons of fresh water annually.
