Notable

- Brandon Razo was named the 2023 GCSAA Emerging Leader Award recipient.
- The nines are switched for the tournament from regular member play.
- A new pro tee was built on tournament No. 14 ahead of last year's event but was not used. It will be used for the first time this year.
- In the last two years the course has reduced its fairway size by 6.5 acres (3 acres in 2023 and 3.5 in 2024).
- In 2021 combined bunker square feet was reduced from 100,000 to 53,000 square feet.
